**5. New members (recruitment)**

**6. Access to and from the Church on Sundays, and for Weddings.**

The ringers asked whether it would be possible to leave through the side door on Sundays and Weddings so as not to disturb the services. Meg offered to check the door was shut after the ringers departed.

**7. Belfry access and keys.**

James asked for it to be minuted that the bell chamber is a dangerous place, especially should the bells be up and anyone wishing to go through the chamber should contact him to check that it is safe.

**Geoff** offered to make a sign indicating the above which could be attached to the trapdoor into the bells.

**8. Future works on the bells**

James H informed the meeting that bells 2-5 are hung on wooden headstocks with original fittings and that some of the bolts have seized. Eventually, some work is going to need to be done, possibly fitting new metal headstocks.

**James H** – to send costing for project and copy of annual maintenance report from Whites of Appleton to James W. Also to investigate grants which may help fund raising.

## 9. Ringing room

**Dave** has been tidying and will look at some of the old heaters to see if they can be donated to the church bazaar. He will check with the church before disposing of them  
There is no material dampness up in the ringing room.

## 10. Simulator

Marika explained the principle behind a simulator in that it allows bands to practice without the bells sounding, it can also help improve striking. She reported that it could cost as much as £500 to put a system in place and that this could be too much for the tower. James W and Meg pointed out that there could be money from grants from Wheatley Charities and the Emma Wilson fund, especially if it could be used to help teach children.

**Marika** – to put together a case for the simulator and investigate possible funding through grants.

## 11. Extra ringing

It was decided it might be possible to ring a qp every other month or so, possibly 4-6pm on a Saturday. Subject to lack of complaints from nearby residents.

A peal was asked for and the date of 30 December was put forward.
